

How to Mount 1-Strap Bike Bag

Note: The 1 strap version is made for Brooks saddles. If you don't have a Brooks or another type of saddle with slots to hold the bag, I suggest that you use my 2-strap version that buckles inside.



Step 1) Pass strap through the right side bag mount slot. If you have trouble with the bag rolling back, you can loop the strap around the bag mount a second pass to tack it down.



Step 2) Then through the O-ring on the bag



Step 3) Then around the seat post and back through the O-ring a second time.



Step 4) Then through the left side bag mount slot.



Step 5) Then through the leather keeper on the bag.



Step 6) Buckle and enjoy!
